

FACILITY: AUSTRIAN CDM/JI PROJECT PROCUREMENT AND CER/ERU SALE FRAMEWORK AGREEMENT

By means of this structured cooperation between the Swiss company South Pole and the Austrian JI/CDM Programme, South Pole procures a total volume of **2.155.000 t CO_{2e}** primarily from CDM Projects (whereby JI Projects are not excluded). The emission reductions will be delivered at guaranteed prices under an ERPA between South Pole and the Austrian JI/CDM Programme.

The procurement of emission reductions follows the agreed specific project-selection and due diligence criteria of the Austrian JI/CDM Programme. The focus lies – in this priority – on renewable energy projects and energy efficiency projects, followed by projects with a component for the avoidance of methane. Regional focus of the facility are host countries in Asia and Africa (i.e. *Thailand, Philippines, Indonesia, India, Vietnam and South Africa*).

Under this cooperation, South Pole assumes significant functions with regard to the structuring and development of individual projects as CDM/JI projects up to their registration under the UNFCCC.
